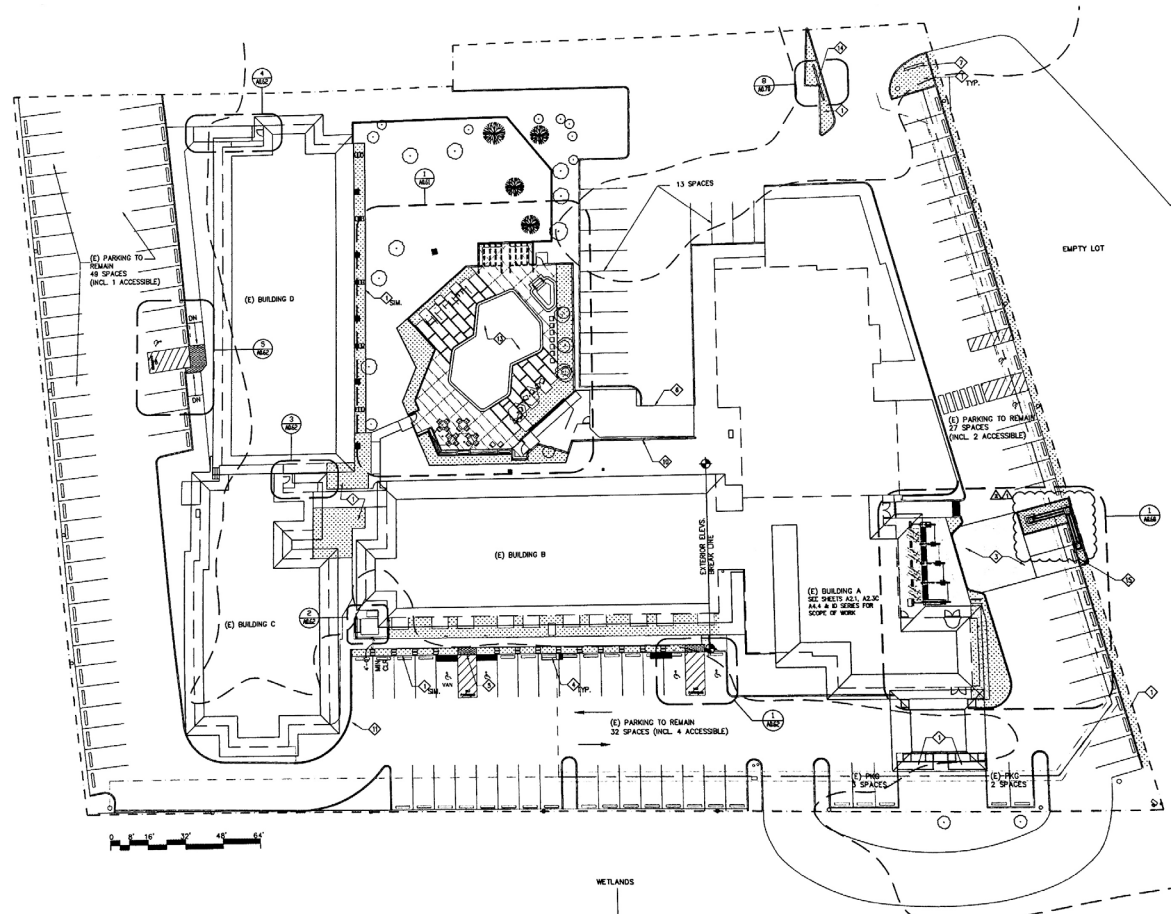


Larkspur Hotel Renovation

Mill Valley, CA

This project consisted of upgrades to an existing 2-star hotel to classify it a 3-star hotel, as well as updating accessibility on the site to meet California Accessibility standards.

Upgrades included re-design the whole exterior look of the building from a mission style to a more craftsman style. We achieved this by enlarging the exterior windows, installing new hardiboard board and batten cladding, providing custom woodwork details, as well as custom lighting made by a local artist.

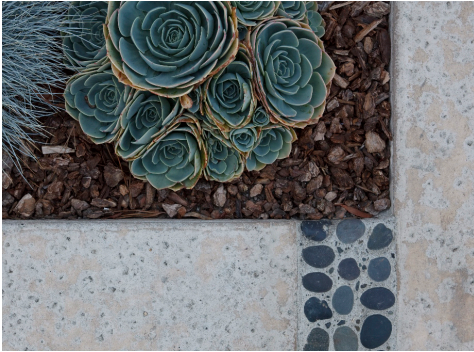
